## **CENTRE RULES**

### ***The playing surface:-***

- ☺ Footwear used on the playing surface must not include cleats or sprigs and must be completely free of dirt and stones.
- ☺ The surface may be entered only through the gates. Players may not jump the fence either to leave or enter the surface.
- ☺ Goalkeeper's buckles must be taped.
- ☺ While games are in progress, warming up must be done outside the perimeter fence on the paved area.
- ☺ Sitting on the turf fence is not permitted.

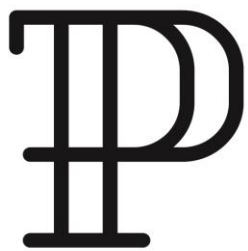
