

2021 Otago Hockey Association Information Sheet

Closing date: 31st August 2020

In 2019 Otago Polytechnic (OP) with the Otago Hockey Association (OHA) established the OHA scholarship to assist students with both sporting and academic aspirations. Two Scholarship's will be offered at the discretion of the OHA for FULL payment of fees for a chosen programme at OP.

The following conditions apply:

- 2 FULL fees scholarships of up to three years continuous full time study will be awarded at the discretion of the OHA for study starting in the year 2020.
- Candidates for the scholarship must be nominated by the OHA.
- Student must provide evidence of successful completion of 70% or more of enrolled courses to attain the scholarship for the following year, and continued engagement in the commitments of the sport. Failure to do so may result in the cancelation of your existing scholarship.
- Continuous study may include a bridging programme. For example, the Certificate in Health (Level 4) and the first two years of a health degree. The student would be responsible for the full fees of the third year of the degree.
- This scholarship applies to Domestic students only.
- The scholarship may be held concurrently with other awards/grants, subject to approval of OP.
- Candidates must meet minimum entry requirements for their programme of choice.
- OP and the OHA has the power to terminate the scholarship if the recipient ceases to follow regulations of the programme of study, fails to engage in the sporting commitments as stipulated by OHA and/or bring the reputation of the OP or the OHA into disrepute.
- Signed acceptance form should be returned in the provided return envelope back to OP Customer Services before the closing date of 31st August 2020.
